



2023 National Junior Dorset Tracy Repasky Memorial Scholarship Awards

The National Junior Dorset Association annually presents up to three \$1000 scholarships. **To qualify, a student must be completing at least half of his or her college or technical school studies the year in which the application is made or be enrolled in graduate school.** The applicant can not be in a Dual Enrollment program (*being enrolled in High School and College at the same time*).

These awards are available to current and previous members of the Continental Dorset Club Youth Enrollment Program or current lifetime members of the Continental Dorset Club. Applicants may be majoring or specializing in any type of field as these awards are not limited to agricultural majors. Applicants may receive the NJDA Tracy Repasky Memorial Scholarship only once.

The application and resume for the Junior Dorset Association Scholarship Awards is attached and must be postmarked **September 1, 2023**. Two letters of recommendation must be enclosed with the application. The individual completing the recommendation may return it to you in a sealed envelope, which has been signed over the flap.
