Dorset Ewes for Youth Grant Application

The Dave & Kathie Harmann Dorset Ewes for Youth Grant program was created to award (up to five) \$500 grants to youth applicants to be applied toward the purchase of a registered Dorset female. The Continental Dorset Club will award three of the grants and the National Junior Dorset Association will award two of the grants to the winning applicants.

RULES:

1. Open to youth in the following age divisions (age as of January 1 of the next year):
Junior: 8 - 10 years of age
Intermediate: 11 – 14 years of age
Senior: 15 -18 years of age
2. An individual may only win each division one time
3. The winning applicants will receive their grant money upon the completed transfer of the ewe(s) purchased into their individual name.
4. Ewe(s) purchased may be any age or type of registered Dorset
5. Ewe(s) may not be purchased from a family member.
